Questioning for Literacy

Comprehension	Accuracy
What connections can you make to this? What does this remind you of? What does this make you think of?	Can you try to sound out the word?
Fluency	Expand Vocabulary
Can you make your voice sound like the character? Can you use the punctuation to help you read?	What doesmean? Use the pictures and clues in the text, What do you think it might mean?





Questioning for Student Wellbeing

Pursue your Personal Bet No Matter Who You Work with

- Is this your Personal Best?
- Are you encouraging others to do their Personal Best?
- Is school a competition?

Have Reasons For the Things You Say and Do

Can you tell me why you did that?

It takes great strength to be sensible

- Are you making a strong decision or a weak decision?
- Are you having a strong moment or a weak moment?
- Are you using self-control?
- Are you in control of your body?



Questioning for Student Wellbeing

Treat others as you would like them to treat you

- Are you treating others how you would like them to treat you?
- Is that a kind thing to do?
- Would you like to be a kind person? What do you need to change to do that?

Be Brave-Participate to Progress

- Is it OK to make a mistake?
- What did you learn?
- We get better at the things we practise, what are you getting better at?
- Do something, go somewhere. Do nothing, go nowhere. What would you like to do?
