PREPARATION

To prepare you for volunteering, there are a number of tasks you need to do:

- 1. You need to make sure that the classroom teacher knows you are helping out in the class. Please confirm the time and date with your child's teacher.
- 2. Please ensure that younger siblings are not with you when you volunteer.
- 3. With excursions and camps, you will have registered your interest at the office. Please ensure you have received a confirmation from the teacher that you are volunteering.

- This is so we know who to call in case of an emergency with you.

CHILD SAFETY



SIGNING IN

- When you arrive at the office you need to sign in on the iPad there.
- It will ask you for basic information such as your name and working with children check number. It will then print name tag sticker for you to wear during your stay.
- Don't forget you need to sign out at the office when you are finished!



WORKING IN THE CLASSROOM

- When working in the classroom, you will be under the supervision of the classroom teacher.
- The teacher will give you directions on how you will help in the classroom. It may be helping students individually or working with a small group.
- If you are concerned about children not being on task or you have a question about what you are doing, please ask the classroom teacher.



EXCURSIONS

- When going on an excursion you will work under the supervision of the teacher.
- They may assign you a small group of students to supervise during the excursion.
- They will give you instructions on what you need to do.
- It is advisable that you stay within eyesight of the teacher in case you need to refer to them.
- If you have any questions about what you need to do, you should ask the teacher.



CAMPS

- On camp, you will usually be assigned an activity group to work with.
- The camp leaders and teachers will be there to assist you. Your main role is to assist in the supervision of the students.
- A separate camp induction will also be sent to you prior to going on camp.
- You'll be rewarded at camp with some good food and the experience is a lot of fun!



CONFIDENTIALITY

- When working in the classroom, helping out at an excursion or camp you will see and hear some confidential information.
- For example, in the classroom you may see the reading levels of students.
- On camp you may see students take medication under the supervision of a teacher.
- It is important that you keep this information to yourself and not share it with other family members or adults in or outside the school.
- Please do not take photos or videos of students while volunteering unless asked to by the teacher.
- When working with students, it is important that you maintain some distance between you and not engage in physical touching.
- Please talk to the teacher if you are concerned about a child's behaviour.



FIRST AID

- Sometimes accidents or first aid is needed by students.
- If you are assisting a group and first aid is needed, please alert the teacher. They will send the student to the office to be looked after by Gill.
- On camps and excursions, the teachers carry a first bag with them. Please take students to the teachers when out of the school.



OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY

- There are a number of occupational health and safety procedures you should know about when you are volunteering.
- You may be volunteering at a time when we are completing a fire drill. Please follow the teacher's instructions during this time so you are accounted for.
- There may be a hazard that you see, for example a fallen tree or a door that doesn't close properly. Please report these to the office.
- Just a note that smoking and vaping is not permitted on school grounds at any time.
